Senate Act 43-22:

To Appropriate funding for Coalition to Stop Campus Hunger SPRING 2022 RIO Funding Event

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

In addition to the SPRING 2022 RIO Funding Cycle, Coalition to Stop Campus Hunger is requesting funding for two events. Two events: Cooking show and MicroGreen Workshop. These events were not included in Senate Act 38-22 SPRING 2022 RIO Funding because of unforeseen communication issues. ASUH will complete this order to justifiably give funding to this RIO for following all eligibility processes and completion of their application. This RIO receiving funding has met all deadlines and requirements.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2,145.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325242 (RIO Funding Account).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

ASUH shall be recognized as co-funding this event at said event and on all advertising with the phrase “partially funded by ASUH.” Partial funding of said event shall not constitute co-sponsorship by ASUH. ASUH neither implies nor accepts any liability as a result of partially funding said event.

All funding for the line items “food” and “food supplies” shall not go towards alcoholic beverages.

ASUH shall be recognized as a sponsor/co-sponsor of this event/project.

All RIO’s are required to use their funding for the benefit of undergraduates at the University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa.

Due to the ongoing pandemic, the past community service requirement has been

temporarily modified to follow state guidelines. Community service is not required during this funding cycle.

All funded events must comply with state and federal guidelines relating to the COVID-19 pandemic.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 4, 2022, shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
