Senate Act 27-22:

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR A UPASS SURVEY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for a survey platform to conduct the fall 2021 UPASS Survey. This survey will gather opinions from the student body at UH Mānoa with regards to the UPASS and UPASS Fee. With the results from this survey, ASUH will take appropriate action to address received concerns and to negotiate the next UPASS contract accordingly.

In addition, as an incentive, students who complete the survey will be entered into a drawing for the chance to win one of several prizes. After the survey is closed, survey participants will be randomly selected to receive these prizes

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$1000.00 shall be appropriated from the Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

The Student Affairs Committee shall be in charge of creating the survey and interpreting its results.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval.
