SENATE ACT 30-22:

To Appropriate Funding for the ASUH Sustainability Policy Workshop

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

Climate change and environmental problems consistently ranks as one of the top priorities for Generation Z, which is the majority of ASUH constituents. To solve these issues, there will need to be collaboration between scientists and engineers and lawmakers. Hawai'i is striving to continue being a strong leader in the environmental science and law fields. However, there is still room for improvement. This bill will appropriate funding for an ASUH Sustainability Policy Workshop that will target STEM students who have an interest in the environment. Any ASUH constituent is able to attend the event, but it will be specifically geared towards STEM majors since students from these fields are not as exposed to the legislative process. This event will teach constituents how ASUH bills and resolutions are written. All bills and resolutions will be centered around sustainability and the environment. Then students will have the opportunity to submit testimony on behalf of the bills and resolutions presented at the workshop. More information about the ASUH legislation process will be provided. This event will be co-hosted with SOEST Club on April 1st, 2022 at 2:00 pm at SOEST Video Wall room. SOEST Club will help by providing facilities for the workshop.
