**SENATE ACT 37-22:**

**To Appropriate Funding for the Undergraduate Professional Headshot Event**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:**

**SECTION I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for the “Undergraduate Professional Headshot Event.” When applying to jobs, internships, or other opportunities, students are required to provide a headshot along with their application. Because of this, Campus Life would like to host this event, on April 19th and 21st from 10:30am to 1pm, where students are able to have professional headshots taken of them, without having to worry about the financial burden associated with them.
