SENATE ACT 23-17

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR COLLEGE MENTAL HEALTH LUNCHEON

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The Associated Students of the University of Hawai‘i (ASUH), originally called the Associated Students of the College of Hawai‘i, was chartered by the Board of Regents in 1912 to act as the student government representing all classified full-time undergraduate students. The purpose of this bill is to fund an informal luncheon between students and Hawai‘i State Senator Stanley Chang so that the issue of mental health amongst college students can be discussed. This luncheon will work in tandem to ASUH’s efforts to pass the Mental Health bill. This event will be held on April 12, 2017.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$1450.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

The ASUH shall be recognized as a sponsor of the event.

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriations of this act as of the close of business on May 3, 2017 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval.
