Relating to Art

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for services to paint a mural. The proposed funding will be used for painting of a mural and an art gallery around aloha 'āina. The mural would last 40-50 years and will send a powerful and inspiring message to the many generations of students that would pass through of the potential for our campuses to reach its goals of carbon neutrality (renewable energy depicted), zero waste (composting/recycling everywhere), and local food self-sufficiency (to grow more edible food).

SECTION II **APPROPRIATIONS**

A total of \$2,000.00 shall be appropriated from ASUH Account 325222 (University Programs, Services, and Support) for:

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
