SENATE ACT 24-17

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR SINCLAIR STUDY NIGHTS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for Sinclair Study Nights, which will provide students with snacks and drinks during late night hours for each night of finals week.

Our goal is to create a welcoming and safe environment for students to study, while also offering students a break from the stress of exams. It is ASUH's way of giving thanks during the end of the semester to our constituents as they engage in hours of studying. Additionally, it encourages students to take full advantage of library resources.

This event will take place at Sinclair Study Library from Sunday, May 7 – Thursday, May 11, 2017.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS
