**2014 ACE BASH**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I:

PURPOSE

First Year Programs would like to host an end of the semester celebration for all freshman enrolled in our ACE learning communities. ACE learning communities offer a combination of three general education courses and a small group, 1-credit integrating seminar (CAS 110: Access to the College Community). Courses are grouped to provide freshman with an introduction to various academic perspectives while fulfilling graduation requirements. CAS 110 is led by an undergraduate peer mentor who supports freshman cohorts in their new learning environment.

First Year Programs has hosted ACE Bash since 2007 as a way to recognize students’ success and progress in higher education, as well as promote student involvement and interaction within UH Mānoa campus community. This Fall 2014 semester, over 430 freshmen have enrolled in the ACE learning communities, a 25% increase in enrollment compared to the Fall 2013 semester. Additionally, we have increased our number of ACE peer mentors to 30, and have a total of 46 learning communities. We hope that the ACE Bash provides fun and social environment where ACE students can interact with the many faculty, peer mentors, and professional staff that have contributed to the overall success of the ACE learning communities.

This event will take place Wednesday, October 29, 2014 at the Campus Center Ballroom from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Food, entertainment, games, and prizes will be provided for all participants
