SENATE ACT 20-18

FUNDING FOR THE HELE LĀLANI MALUHIA O LILI‘U Ē

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding to help raise awareness in the student body about the 125th Commemoration of the Illegal Overthrow of the Hawaiian Kingdom that took place on January 17, 1893. Native Hawaiian Student Services, the Political Science Department and the Hawai‘inui‘ākea School of Hawaiian Knowledge are working collaboratively to plan protocol training activities on campus and encourage students to participate in the Peace March in memory of Queen Lili‘uokalani, the last ruling Monarch of the Hawaiian Kingdom, from the Royal Mausoleum to ‘Iolani Palace on January 17, 2018. ASUH will encourage students to engage and participate in Native Hawaiian protocol and activities planned for this day by sponsoring buses, advertisements and promotional items.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2760.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

ASUH shall be recognized as a co-sponsor of this event.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
