SENATE ACT 8-15

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ASUH ELECTIONS BANNERS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The Associated Students of the University of Hawai‘i (ASUH), originally called the Associated Students of the College of Hawai‘i, was chartered by the Board of Regents in 1912 to act as the student government representing all classified full-time undergraduate students. The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for banners in order to advertise for future elections.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$750.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325222 (Senate)

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

The ASUH Elections Committee shall be in charge of purchasing the banners and designing them.

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriations of this act as of the close of business on May 6, 2015 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325222.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval from the Senate.
