SENATE ACT 22-19

FUNDING FOR ADVERTISEMENTS FOR THE RALLY AT THE LEGISLATURE FOR MAUNA KEA

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

On November 6, 2013, the ASUH passed Senate Resolution 13-14 entitled “In Opposition to the Renewal of Leases on Mauna a Wākea without Further Input from Stakeholders” recognizing the adverse impact that telescopes, including the proposed Thirty Meter Telescope (TMT), have had and will have on the fragile cultural and ecological environments of the Mauna Kea summits. Despite this, numerous attempts have been made to construct TMT on the Northern Plateau of the Mauna Kea summits, resulting in the arrests of 57 Protectors (including UH students and staff/faculty) and 9 years of legal hearings and precedings. On October 30, 2018, the Hawai’i State Supreme Court finally upheld the Board of Land and Natural Resources decision to issue a construction permit for the TMT. In response to this decision, many UH students, staff, and faculty will be heading to the Hawai’i State Legislature to the “Stand for the Mauna” Rally to help raise awareness on the value of protecting Mauna Kea as a finite cultural resource and fragile ecological environment. ASUH will be joining others like UH Mānoa’s Native Hawaiian Student Services and Hawaiiinuiākea: The School of Hawaiian Knowledge in supporting a rally for Mauna Kea at the Hawai’i State Capitol on Wednesday, January 16, 2019.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

In accordance to the ASUH Senate Rule 27-1(h), the non-ASUH organization that may be funded is required to submit a follow up report on the proposed event or program. The follow up report shall include information regarding finances if any appropriations had been made in this measure to said organization.

ASUH shall be consulted during the design of the banners and advertisements.

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriations of this act as of the close of business on May 1, 2019 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
