SENATE ACT 06-16

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR GRAD FAIR

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for the Grad Fair event that will be held on Friday, October 16, 2015. Grad Fair is an opportunity for undergraduate students to meet with representatives from different colleges and schools of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Graduate Programs. Members of the Graduate Student Organization, Graduate Education Office of the Dean from the requested schools, colleges and departments selected by the Undergraduate Academic Affairs Committee. The Grad Fair event supports the goals of the Undergraduate Academic Affairs Committee to become a resource to the students, and encourage students to consider UH Mānoa's academic opportunities. These items of spending are allocated for the undergraduate students attending the requested event.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2,850 shall be appropriated from the Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

ASUH shall be the sponsor of this event.

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this act as of the close of business on May 4, 2016 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval from the Senate.
