**SENATE ACT 04-17**

**TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR AS(YOU)H WEEK**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:**

**SECTION I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for AS(YOU)H, a two-day event dedicated to increasing awareness of the ASUH and its vision to “empower students through advocacy.” Held in Campus Center Courtyard on Monday, September 19, to Tuesday, September 20, AS(YOU)H will foster interaction between Senate members and undergraduates, enabling Senate members to inform students about resources and to directly hear the comments and concerns of those they serve. By building greater familiarity with the ASUH among the student body, this event hopes to garner more participation in the Fall Special Election and beyond.

**SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS**

A total of \$3,650.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

**SECTION V.** The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

**SECTION IV.** This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
