**SENATE ACT 28-16**

**TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ONE BILLION RISING 2016**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

**SECTION I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of the One Billion Rising 2016 event is to increase awareness of and provide education for preventing sexual and domestic violence against women. One Billion Rising takes its name from the statistic that one in three women around the world will experience sexual or domestic violence during their lifetime. The goal of the One Billion Rising campaign is to end violence against women.

One Billion Rising 2016 will be hosted by the PAU (Prevention, Awareness, and Understanding) Violence Program through the Women's Center at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. Through this event, PAU Violence will introduce attendees to on-campus and community services available to assist with situations of sexual and domestic violence. PAU Violence aims to provide a fun and engaging venue for students to learn about the various ways that they can get involved in ending gender-based violence, including through a choreographed dance to express global solidarity.

The One Billion Rising 2016 event will take place on Wednesday, February 10, 2016 from 3pm-7pm at the Campus Center Courtyard. All students and community members are welcome to attend this event.
