Senate Act 3-15

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR GRAD FAIR

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for the Grad-Ed Mixer event held on Wednesday, April 15, 2015. Grad-Ed Mixer is an opportunity for undergraduate students to meet with representatives from different colleges and schools of the University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa Graduate Program. Members of the Graduate Student Organization, Center of Teaching Excellence and Graduate Education Office of the Dean are from the requested schools, colleges and departments selected by the Undergraduate Academic Affairs Committee. These items of spending are allocated for the undergraduate students attending the requested event.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2,650.00 shall be appropriated from the Senate Account 3325232 (university programs and support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

It will be the duty of the Undergraduate and Academic Affairs Committee to generate and approve said advertisements.

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this act as of the close of business on May 6, 2015 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval of the budget.
