**SENATE ACT 41-16**

**TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR THE 2016 EARTH DAY**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

**SECTION I. PURPOSE**

Since 2005, the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa (UHM) has celebrated Earth Day, an annual tradition which promotes existing sustainability efforts on-campus and in the community to foster networking, involvement, inspiration, and a sense of momentum in sustainability and environmental protection. This year, it will be commemorated on April 22, 2016 from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the Campus Center Courtyard.

The UHM has a specific goal for Earth Day, which is to educate students about simple behavioral changes that can be adopted to amplify sustainability efforts and mitigate climate change. The Earth Day celebration will bring people together and there will be guest performances taking place throughout the day. Well-known artists such as Mike Love, Kealoha, Phil Strauss, Johnathan Osorio, and the Paul Izak will be performing.
