SENATE ACT 02-18

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ASUH UNIFORMS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i (ASUH), originally called the Associated Students of the College of Hawai'i, was chartered by the Board of Regents in 1912 to act as the student government representing all classified full-time undergraduate students. The purpose of this bill is to provide uniforms, in the form of polo shirts, for all ASUH Senate members. Having uniform polos will help to promote unity within the ASUH, as well as increase the visibility of the ASUH. Each uniform will have the ASUH logo displayed on the front and MĀNOA on the sleeve - the polos shall be worn by all ASUH members at ASUH sponsored events.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$1,500.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325222 (Senate)

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

The ASUH shall be recognized as sponsor of the polos. The ASUH External Affairs Committee shall be in charge of the purchasing of the polos.

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriations of this act as of the close of business on May 2, 2018 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325222.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate, pending on the approval of the ASUH Budget by all required signatories.
