SENATE ACT 21-17

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR THE ASUH ARCHIVAL PROJECT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

In order to provide transparency and more access to many of its important documents and historical materials, the ASUH is in the process of archiving thousands of documents and artifacts. These items have already been surveyed and are now being inventoried, scanned, labeled, and filed both physically and electronically. These documents and artifacts include Senate Acts, Resolutions, Presidential Messages, Standing Committee Reports, Student Court documents, t-shirts, banners, signs, flyers, etc. from January 1912 to the present. The physical original documents and artifacts are being prepped to be stored at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Hamilton Library Archives accessible during Library hours and wherever possible available online. Currently we will be going into the second year (started in Fall 2016) of a three year project in cooperation with the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Library and Information Science Program and the Archivist for University Records.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$7,000.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

ASUH shall be recognized as the sponsor of this project.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 03, 2017 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
