SENATE ACT 21-19

FUNDING FOR A SUSTAINABILITY ON CAMPUS SURVEY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

This survey will gauge student opinions on establishing a student fee overseen by students to support sustainability projects on campus. The survey results will detail the amount, if any, that students are willing to pay into the sustainability fee. With the results, the ASUH will take the appropriate actions to received concerns. In the past, the ASUH has taken a stance in supporting the creation of this student sustainability fee.

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding to the Information Technology Services (ITS) department at UH Mānoa. The funds will pay for services provided by ITS to distribute the survey through MyUH.

As an incentive, students who complete the survey will be entered into a drawing for the chance to win one of several prizes, which may include an insulated cup, a speaker, a pair of headphones, and gift cards, etc. After the survey is closed, survey participants will be randomly selected to receive these prizes. Pre-packaged foods and snacks will also be given out to entice students to fill out the survey.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$600.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support).

The Students Affairs Committee will be in charge of administering the survey.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.
