**Senate Act 36-15**

**TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR THE S.P.A.M STUDENT PARENT RESOURCE FAIR**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

**SECTION I. PURPOSE**

To provide funds to support the growth and outreach efforts of Student Parents at Mānoa (SPAM). S.P.A.M assists student parents with campus and community resources, including referrals, to help them succeed in their educational goals. S.P.A.M acts as an important resource base providing information about childcare and social services. The SPAM program advocates for expecting student parents, parents of children with special needs and supports the expansion of student friendly lactation spaces on campus.

While celebrating Non-Traditional Students, S.P.A.M supports our families here at UH Mānoa and in the community. S.P.A.M hopes that ASUH will continue to support celebrating non-tradition students and SPAM as an annually celebrated event. Celebrating the diversity of our students and helping one another brings unity and solidarity to our campus.

S.P.A.M requests that ASUH sponsor this event with us. Funding would help to promote advertising, provide food, promotional items and prizes.
