Senate Act 11-16

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR A SPEED READING WORKSHOP

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for a 3.5 hour Speed Reading Workshop for University of Hawaii at Manoa. The workshop will be held at UH Manoa on September 22, 2015 and can accommodate approximately 50 people.

The instructor will show students how to apply practical speed-reading techniques to different levels of reading (textbooks, technical material, standardized reading tests), with a strong emphasis placed on comprehension and memory concept strategies. This skill-set allows students to become more efficient readers, and the primary objective is to increase your speed without sacrificing comprehension. Everyone makes an immediate improvement during the session, and supplemental web-based training tools will be provided to reinforce techniques for continuous improvement.

The invoice for the Speed Reading Workshop was received on July 9, 2015 for a total of \$3,500.00. The money appropriated with this bill will be used to compensate Iris Reading for the workshop.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$3,600 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

It will be the duty of the Undergraduate Academic Affairs Committee to facilitate this event.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 4, 2016 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
