Homecoming 2016

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I PURPOSE

Homecoming 2016 will be held on October 14th, 2016 from 4:00-8:00 pm at the Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex. The event “Na ‘ono o Mānoa - The Flavors of Mānoa” will feature food trucks and vendors by Eat the Street and Night Market, entertainment from the UH Athletic Teams, Pep Band, and Cheerleaders, and various activities.

This year’s Homecoming, which is being planned by the Office of the Chancellor and other UHM Organizations, aims to bring alumni back to campus and increase a sense of community. As the undergraduate student government, ASUH will be providing t-shirts, organizing an RIO fair, and advertising to constituents.
