Fall 2014 RIO Mixer

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I PURPOSE

The Associated Students of the University of Hawai‘i (ASUH) currently assists Registered Independent Organizations (RIO) at the University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa (UHM) through its RIO Funding cycle every semester. In its operating budget, the ASUH appropriated \$65,000.00 for the year to allocate towards RIOs to fund their programs and events throughout the academic year. In order to maximize the awareness of these funding and other RIO-support organizations on campus, the ASUH would like to hold an RIO Mixer in collaboration with the Student Activity and Program Fee Board (SAPFB), Student Athletic Fee Committee (SAFC), and the Campus Center Board Activities Council (CCBAC).

The RIO Mixer will be held on Thursday, September 11, 2014 from 5:30pm – 7:00pm at the Campus Center Ballroom. ASUH, SAPFB, SAFC, SLD and CCBAC shall collaborate to spread the awareness of the funding and co-sponsorship opportunities available for RIOs to take advantage of. The event will also serve to educate RIO leaders of how each organization’s funding/co-sponsorship opportunities work in order to reduce any confusion or issues that may come about throughout the year. The event will also be a time for RIO leaders to network with ASUH leaders and other RIO leaders to have discussions of ways future collaboration can occur.

Current RIO presidents along with two other executive members registered under the Office of Student Life and Development (SLD) will be invited to the event. It is highly encouraged that the treasurer is one of the two executive members accompanying the president.

SECTION II APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2,000.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III PROVISIONS

The ASUH shall be recognized as sponsoring this event.

SECTION IV Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriations of this act as of the close of business on May 6, 2015 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
