SENATE ACT 17-16

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR A NATIONAL COMING OUT DAY FAIR

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

National Coming Out Day stresses that no matter your sexual orientation, you are not alone. Members of the LGBT community, and young people in particular, often feel isolated or that they must hide who they are to be treated fairly, with respect, and to live safely. The purpose of a National Coming Out Day Fair is to celebrate diversity, equality, and the collaborative support for all members of the campus community.

The fair will take place in Campus Center on Monday October 12, 2015 from 11:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. In addition to LGBT Student Services, other programs that participate in National Coming Out Day to promote gender equity include the Women's Center, Campus Security, Counseling and Student Development, and SEED.

Past National Coming Out Day celebrations have featured educational booths, games, music, community agencies and organizations. The event is open to all University of Hawaii at Manoa students, and seeks to build a greater campus community by reaching out to both LGBT students , as well as LGBT allies.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$4,175.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).
