SENATE ACT 35-18

To Appropriate Funding for an ASUH & GSO Spring 2018 Town Hall Event

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I PURPOSE

The ASUH and GSO will be hosting its second Town Hall Event this year to provide an avenue for students to 1) learn about University Resources that correlate to areas of student interest and concern, 2) to meet and have conversations with relevant university and community entities and administration, and 3) be able to direct general student concerns and ideas to both student government organizations to strengthen the student voice and guide ASUH and GSO to advocate collaboratively. The student attendance and participation at this event will also help ASUH and GSO improve its engagement with its constituents, and better gauge the student perspective to guide ASUH and GSO's advocacy efforts. The Town Hall "theme" this Town Hall is "Campus Safety" and will take place in the first week of April.

This year, the ASUH & GSO is working on unifying and strengthening the student voice. Efforts such as hosting this event are directly related to that. For this event, ASUH will be working on advertising (graphics) and provide funding for refreshments. GSO will also help advertise the event, and has rented out the venue and necessary equipment. Both ASUH and GSO will be working on ways to collect student concerns at the event.

SECTION II APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$350.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

ASUH shall be recognized as co-funding the events and on all advertising with the phrase "partially funded by ASUH". Partially funding of said events shall not constitute co-sponsorship by ASUH. ASUH neither implies nor accepts any liability as a result of partially funding said events.

SECTION IV. Any unexpected or unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this act as of the close of business on May 02, 2018 shall lapse into Senate Account 3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
