SENATE ACT 06-18

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ASUH UNIFORMS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

This bill appropriates funds to order polo shirts and nametags for all ASUH Senate members in the aims to appear unified and professional when representing the full-time undergraduate students body during ASUH sponsored events and other work related functions. The apparel top will consist of the ASUH logo and Mānoa on a sleeve to distinguish from other University of Hawai‘i student governments. The nametag will feature the name and position of each individual Senate member. Wearing the uniform at ASUH sponsored events is an expectation for Senate members.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$1,950.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

The ASUH shall be recognized as sponsor of the polos. The ASUH External Affairs Committee shall be in charge of the design and purchasing of the polos.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 1, 2019 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
