SENATE ACT 11-19

FUNDING FOR THE STUDENT SUCCESS CENTER COMPUTERS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to fund the Student Success Center (SSC). SSC is an office under the Office of Undergraduate Education whose purpose is to “bring together a number of resources to enhance student engagement, learning, and achievement. It is a place where students can work independently, as well as with tutors, mentors, academic advisors, librarians, faculty, and staff to meet their educational goals. SSC provides front desk concierge, room reservations, and exam proctoring services for UHM students, faculty, and staff at Sinclair Library.

This bill is to appropriate money to fund computers and monitors for SSC’s exam proctoring center. SSC offers exam proctoring for UH distance-learning courses. This service is free of charge and increasingly utilized. In academic year 2015-2016, 1,076 users utilized the computers. Last academic year, 2017-2018, the number of users increased to 1,437. SSC was able to replace five of the computers used to proctor exams for students, which was quite needed given the dire state of this equipment. The bill will fund for replacing the 3 of the 10 remaining computers in the exam proctoring center, which are also in dire condition.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$4,145.88 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

In accordance to the ASUH Rules, the non-ASUH organization that may be funded is required to submit a follow up report on the proposed event or program. The follow up report shall include information regarding finances if any appropriations had been made in this measure to said organization.

ASUH shall be recognized as funding for the equipment that was provided with the phrase, “Provided by ASUH.”

ASUH neither implies nor accepts any liability as a result of partially funding said program.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 1, 2019 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate, pending on the approval of the ASUH Budget by all required signatories.
