SENATE ACT 09-18

FUNDING FOR GRAD FAIR 2017

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for the Grad Fair event that will be held on Thursday, October 26 and Friday, October 27, 2017. Grad Fair is an opportunity for undergraduate students to meet with representatives from different colleges and schools of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Graduate Programs. Members of the Graduate Student Organization, Graduate Education Office of the Dean from the requested schools, colleges and departments selected by the Undergraduate Academic Affairs Committee. The Grad Fair event supports the goals of the Undergraduate Academic Affairs Committee to become a resource to the students, and encourage students to consider UH Mānoa's academic opportunities. These items of spending are allocated to support the undergraduate students attending the requested event.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$4050.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).
