**Senate Bill 02-15**

**TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR EARTH DAY**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:**

**SECTION I.     PURPOSE**

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for additional personal spending funds for the Earth Day event on April 25, 2014. Earth Day was funded by the 101<sup>st</sup> ASUH Senate in Senate Act 26-14. Members of the Sustainability Court, Doorae Shin and Zachary Parlee, spent personal funds for the bands that played and rental of equipment from the Meetings and Events Services (MES). These items of spending were allocated in Senate Act 26-14. All fiscal paperwork was due on May 7, 2014 however, due to unforeseen circumstances with the fiscal procedure, the two students could not get proper reimbursement. This bill will cover the fees they paid.
