SENATE ACT 17-17

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ASUH BLOOD DRIVE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for the Associated Students of the University of Hawai‘i (ASUH) Blood Drive which will be held on Tuesday, November 29th, 2016. Full-time undergraduates that donate blood will be given a t-shirt as a form of thanks. The t-shirts will not have a specified year and can thus be given out at future drives.
