**SENATE ACT 11-25**

**TO ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR A DECOLONIAL NOVEMBER FILM DAY FOR  
PALESTINIAN CINEMA WITH SFJP AND NHSS**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

**SECTION I. PURPOSE**

To allocate funding for an educational film day event on November 2 during Decolonial November, which seeks to present Palestinian cinema and to spread awareness about decolonization and solidarity in other parts of the world. Four short films will be presented and a discussion will follow.

**SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS**

A total of \$349.35 shall be appropriated from Senate Account#3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support) sections C2 and C4, 50% from each respectively.

**SECTION IV.** Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of the business period December 13th, shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232. Specifically Section C2 and Section C4; 50% from each respectively.

**SECTION V.** The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

**SECTION IV.** This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
