A BILL FOR AN ACT

To Appropriate Funding for Series of ASUH Festive October Activities:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

ASUH promotes events relating to current periods and holidays in the year, ranging from cultural, wellbeing, educational, and entertainment. For October, certain dates will correspond to activities ASUH will sponsor and host. On the week and days leading up to October 31st, 2022, a series of entertainment, educational, and cultural events will be coordinated: a Dia de los Muertos event, a gaming event where participants will be entered to a random gift card drawing (total of 3 \$20 gift cards) for playing several rounds of a video game, and a downtown walking tour about local superstitions.

SECTION II. <u>APPROPRIATIONS</u>

A total of \$1,775.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

ASUH senate members and event volunteers are excluded to win any prizes and all offerings are for full-time ASUH fee paying students. Prizes are to be awards by random drawing by sign up sheet of those participating. Purchases for the equipment should be made into ASUH inventory and for future events. Digital waiver will be authorized by each participant for all activities.

An electronic sign up sheet for the event with a waitlist will be generated for the guided walking then verifying students who are qualified ASUH fee paying students will be confirmed and notified of their tickets. Advertisements will be vetted by the external affairs chair, and/or external affairs committee. Volunteers and donors could be commemorated.
