VI. OPEN FORUM

DSS Advisory Council:

- President Reed: Division of Student Success (DSS) advisory council is a new council that will be giving advice from a student perspective. The difference between ASUH and this council is not clear yet, what are the overlaps? Students can nominate other students for the council to avoid double-screening of candidates (ASUH and DSS). The person selected within ASUH will not be automatically placed on the DSS advisory council, so nominations are the proposed solution.
