Program Officer April Goodwin and Educational Specialist Lori Furoyama, Office of the Vice-Chancellor for Academic Affairs: Commencement Proposal

April Goodwin

How many of you are familiar with the Spring undergraduate Commencement Ceremony? Can you tell me how crazy it is and they lock people out? This is a problem with all of our Spring Commencement ceremonies, and has been. If you look at the two charts on the handout I provided for the last 10 years, not only have the number of graduates gone up, but the share of graduates who walk in the ceremony, which is usually one-third, is also increasing. We have an increasing number of graduates and an increasing number of graduates who want to participate which is also excellent, but we are very limited in capacity because the ceremony is in Stan Sheriff Center. So what we need to do is to figure out a way to make the undergraduate ceremony a little bit smaller and also make the advanced degree ceremony in the afternoon bigger. The amount in the undergraduate ceremony is 1800 and the amount in the graduate ceremony is around 700, which is a huge difference. Historically, we've had the undergraduate and graduate ceremonies separate in the spring and combined in the fall. We've explored a few different possibilities, but what we're proposing is that we divide the ceremony by college and school in the spring. We'd like to do a pilot and see how well it works out to have students walk with their college and school from undergraduates to graduates. One drawback is that all of the undergraduates will not be in the same ceremony - there will be two separate ceremonies. We would have an Arts & Sciences ceremony and all of the professional ceremonies will be in the afternoon ceremony. The division makes the two ceremonies of equal and comfortable size at around 1400. I work on the inside for the ceremony, but the ceremony has been a problem for those who work on the outside since they have to deal with such things as angry parents. There'll still be a crowd control issue but it'll be better than if there were 1800 or 1900 graduates. Unfortunately, a lot of parents have to go to the overflow stadium at Les Murakami. Since we don't do ticketing, we can't guarantee that parents will get in so there's often a huge blowup outside where parents are frustrated since they want to see their child graduate. They should be able to see their child graduate but we cannot guarantee that. We've explored providing tickets. The tickets will be problematic because there would be an issue with people not using their tickets, and then there will be empty seats, which would cause even more of an issue since people will see that there are empty seats. The ticket issue works for athletics but not for us. We took this to the deans and the Faculty Senate and they agreed that tickets are probably not the best option. You're the last governance group that we're reaching out to. If you approve this pilot we'll implement this in the Spring and we'll see how it goes. One thing we've heard informally from students is that you identify more with your department and not necessarily with the whole undergraduate or graduate body. Do you feel more connected to your school or college, or do you identify more with your whole class?

Senator Klinestiver

I don't have a lot of friends in my department, but I have a lot of friends outside of my department, so this would be a bummer for me. However, they might be able to come to

my ceremony.

Senator Negrillo

I 'd like to filter the question to those graduating next semester since it's only a pilot

program that'll be implemented.

Senator Delos Reyes Senator Ishii

I am a Political Science major and I identify more with the students in my college.

I also am more connected with Political Science major.

Senator Crollard

What if students have dual degrees?

April Goodwin Even now, we ask students to identify their primary major they would like to walk with.

However, with this scenario, there would be an option for the student to walk twice. If

they want to walk in both ceremonies with their majors that's fine.

VP Dela Cruz When did UH stop the summer commencement

April Goodwin I think that precedes me two or three years. I think that's because there weren't many

people walking in the summer ceremony. My predecessor was the one who implemented

the change. Students now can choose to walk in either ceremony.

Senator Lao Personally, I was more connected to the people outside the department. However, I don't

see an alternative since there are valid concerns with the current number of attendees so I

would be for this.

Senator Wang

I think one major aspect of commencement for the students is the lei ceremony since this

is the time where we see all of our friends. As long as we're still able to see our friends

during this I don't think there should be a problem with this proposal.

April Goodwin If your ceremony was in the afternoon but your friends' ceremony was in the morning,

would you come early to give them a lei?

Senator Wang I wouldn't go to both ceremonies. I would just go for the lei'ing part for the morning

ceremony.

SAL Chen Have you polled students to see what they think will be best?

April Goodwin That's what we're doing here. We're asking governance to give us the blessing for the

pilot. We chose to not take a survey because we felt we'd be asking them what they thought might happen without a concrete experience. We haven't done a survey. If you
