Lori Lum Aloha, I am Lori, and this is Susan, the former Executive Director of PACE (Pacific

Asian Center for Entrepreneurship). UH purchased land off Metcalf street, the Charles Atherton building. We purchased it from the YMCA. The plan is to create a true live work-learning environment that would incorporate not just CIE, student housing, - so that we have community space, learning space. The foundation, with the concept and mission of the University, and the direction, said let's do a private-public partnership. Concept to

do outreach, we'll have a design team. We decided to talk to our undergraduate students, and others involved. WE have a lot of questions and we want some feedback. My job is to get as much feedback. We need feedback, such as food options being open to the public. Others will be concerned about the preservation of the building, etc. I will feed the input back to the project team. Not many universities have programs like this. Hunt, MIT, and Houston have these programs. We have the architect who has done the projects of MIT and stuff.

Susan Yamada

I spent 8 years building the PACE program. It's difficult to get the word out to students. You have to opt in, participate in our competitions, etc. It's a huge and positive resource to elect to participate in this program. Once you graduate, these resources are not available. We're willing to do a lot for students. I left in 2017, and we currently have 15-20 programs now. We have guest speakers, 1-1 consultation, start-up launch pads, business competitions - everything entrepreneurial. What I have learned through those 8 years is that the University is a humongous place, and we're trying to identify students who are interested in entrepreneurship. Our goal is to try to educate you on how to be an entrepreneur. This project will have 200-300 students living, and their goal is how do they contribute to that dorm. In the first year, you need to participate in programs (meet a requirement) to stay in the dorms. It's gonna be very strict, and we don't want "slackers" in their. It doesn't mean the programs will be limited to those who live there. It will be open to everyone. We can select students in all colleges to live in this building. Hopefully get students involved in this early. 7000-8000 sq footage of program space (can't fit in shidler) so we want it here. 1st floor - food and beverage, work space, homework space. 2nd floor space - "work floor", serious teams, assignable cubes, drop-in cubes, programs that support entrepreneurs. 3rd floor - meeting space for students, classroom, all sorts of fields and backgrounds. What our differentiating advantage is our job to teach. What I'm trying to teach is the thought process of what an entrepreneur is like. Learning how to be part of the change. Through entrepreneurship, you can learn to mitigate risks when having this mindset. Goal: everyone to take a class at the center because students should have the mindset to think like this.

You can certainly use our entrepreneurial protocols that can support political science and public policy. It's certainly applicable.
