**TO ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR EDUCATIONAL FILM DAY AND DISCUSSIONS DURING
THE MONTH OF APRIL - "SECOND CHANCE MONTH"**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

To allocate funding for an educational film day(s) event in April, during historically recognized Second Chance Month, which focuses on the reintegration of formerly incarcerated individuals. The documentary film "Out of State" and a short film will be shown with a presentation to follow.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2,900.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support) Account C2 and C4 50% from each respectively.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
