SENATE ACT 22-23

FUNDING FOR ASUH CAMERA WITH VIDEO CAPACITIES AND LENSES:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

ASUH promotes itself in various ways, with the capacity of multi-media use to capture the individual interests of students. Additionally a high quality camera could create occasion headshot opportunities throughout the year, aid in marketing, and assist in operations like streaming events. In the long term investment for ASUH, a camera will provide headshots and group photos of the senate without a photographer. In regards to external promotions of ASUH, great quality photos, video, and streaming will be used for promotional purposes and events. This bill will fund the camera, lenses, a spare battery, a SD card, and a camera bag for protection.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$5,155.29 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

The ASUH shall create risk and loss prevention management procedures for the camera due to the cost of the equipment such as authorized users and activity logs.

The ASUH Office Staff shall keep record of use and possession of the equipment through activity logs.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 6, 2022 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
