**SENATE ACT 06-23**

**TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ASUH UNIFORMS**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:**

**SECTION I. PURPOSE**

This bill appropriates funding to order polo t-shirts and name tags for all ASUH Senate members. The polos will help create a unified and professional image when Senate members are engaging in events relating to ASUH sponsored events and other work related functions. The embroidery on the polo will feature the ASUH logo and islands on the sleeve. This bill also appropriates funding for an ID maker. The ID maker is an investment for the Senate so that the ASUH can create the IDs instead of outsourcing the job. The ID maker will also allow the ASUH to create ID name tags for volunteers who assist at events or RIOS.

**SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS**

A total of \$3,095.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325242 (RIO Funding Account).

**SECTION III. PROVISIONS**

The ASUH shall be recognized as sponsor of the polos.

The ASUH External Affairs Committee shall be in charge of the design and purchasing of the polos.

**SECTION IV.** Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 4, 2023 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

**SECTION V.** The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

**SECTION VI.** This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
