- Senator Schulz* Why are you saying that they are being abused? What is your evidence?
- SAL Mandado* They don’t treat their workers well and they are always at risk of firing them because they take people from the mainland to get them to work for their company and firing the local people.
- Senator Tomono* You can’t really say that because I’m sure other hotels do that, and if they do that, it’s a business strategy so you shouldn’t just say to stay away from the Hyatt.
- SAL Mandado* Yes, but they are the ones starting it so if we stop supporting them, other hotels will do the same.
- Senator Schulz* Those are really big statements being made without evidence.
- President Mizusawa* Who approached you to do this?
- SAL Mandado* Students and a member of the BOR.
- Senator Tomono* I have three points of information. People vote for union so it’s not like they are working there and not knowing what may or may not happen to them, it’s a choice. Secondly, if they fire people in hotels, room service is the first to go because room service doesn’t make as much money for them. And finally, negativity impacts students and the Hyatt provides scholarships and jobs for students here at the University.
