## SENATE RESOLUTION 06-22: IN SUPPORT OF SHUTTING DOWN RED HILL

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE SENATE:

WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa

Senate is the elected body representing approximately 10,000

full-time classified undergraduate students; and,

WHEREAS, The Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility was constructed in 1940 to

support military operations in the Pacific; and,

WHEREAS, The facility, which can hold around 250 million gallons of fuel has

recorded at least seventy-three fuel leaks since 1943; and,

WHEREAS, As of November 20th 2021 the Navy reported a leak of about 14,000

gallons of fuel, but stated that there was no evidence that the fuel had escaped into the surrounding environment and that the drinking

water was safe; and,

WHEREAS, The Navy waited to disclose the information until December 6th,

military residents complain of illnesses, Navy still indicates that the

water is safe; and,

WHEREAS, Testing shows the presence of petroleum in a water sample; now

therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, approximately 400,000 residents from Hālawa to Maunalua depend

on water from the threatened aquifer and many more could be

affected; and,

BE IT RESOLVED, The ASUH senate not only cares about the health and well-being of

UH Mānoa students but the entire Hawai'i community; and,

BE IT RESOLVED, The UH Mānoa community understands the threat that Red Hill

poses towards the health and well being of the land and the people;

and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Is aware that Mālama 'Āina, which represents caring for the land and

natural resources, is central to life in Hawai'i and it's well being. ASUH is also aware that the Navy has been getting away with this

for far too long and needs to be held accountable; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Supports each and every cause actively working to close down the

facility; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Will not stop speaking out about this issue and advocating for the

complete shut down and removal of fuel from The Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility, and encourages each and every student, faculty member, and resident of Hawai'i to stand against the facility and demand that the Navy take full responsibility for their actions; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution shall be sent to: the University of Hawai'i Board of Regents Chair Benjamin Kudo and Members, President David Lassner, Provost Michael Bruno, Interim Vice Chancellor for Students Lori Ideta, the Graduate Student Organization, and Ka Leo O Hawai'i.
