BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

Attending conferences related to student leadership roles provides student leaders the opportunity to learn from industry professionals, network with other student leaders and gain valuable insights into the field. Conference attendance can also be beneficial for personal development and growth as a leader, as it allows student leaders to stay up to date on the latest trends and best practices in the field. Additionally, conferences often feature keynote speakers or panels who provide insight into the field that students may not have access to otherwise. Attending conferences provides student leaders with an opportunity to collaborate with peers, discuss best practices, and brainstorm new ideas for their respective roles.
