TO ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR A CONSTITUENCY DAY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

To allocate funding to support a two-day ASUH hosted event intended for senators of ASUH to interact and converse with the undergraduate constituents of the University. The event will be held on April 13th and 14th, 2026 at Campus Center. This event will also aim to showcase potential candidates for the upcoming general elections along with previous projects introduced by the senate.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$2000.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support) section C2.

ASUH will be the primary sponsor of this event. All funding is pending approval of the ASUH budget by the OVPSS.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 6, 2026 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
