SENATE ACT 13-23

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR HYBRID MEETING EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

ASUH meetings will be hybrid, and to aid meetings, funds will go to purchase meeting minute taking software which could allow greater engagement for those attending and assist in producing meeting minutes more reliably. The software's line item cost is estimated for 12 months. Mainly, such software records and stores meetings while creating a typed transcript when initiated during Zoom meetings. The secretary or a vice-chair could be assisted by spending less effort in meeting minutes.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$300.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
