 - A. Dr. Zimmerman: domestic markets have been quite resilient, protect portfolio where's volatility, how consumers feel in our spending and confidence is important, we need diversification in our portfolio,
 - B. Pres Watson: In terms of foreign markets, are we getting more out of them than we are domestically
 - C. Dr. Zimmerman: that is correct, anytime that the dollar weakens, foreign securities are more attractive
 - D. Dr. Zimmerman: started off the fiscal year in a good way; equal weight limits the concentration risk by Allocating proportionally, international markets are outperforming domestic markets, 503,000 is your cash reserve; you're allotted spending amount for this new fiscal year is \$461,420
 - E. Dr. Zimmerman: I won;t be able to compare how you did to your peers until Feb 2026; it's okay to be a little overweight to equities, cannot be below 40% and cannot be above 80%, sitting at 72.6%; policy states to keep 50,000 minimum in cash
 - F. Pres Watson: Glad to hear markets have been doing well despite federal situations, is it consistent with last term's growth?
