Peter Englert I want to be here this evening to thank you for supporting the reorganization which was approved in the last board meeting. We are looking forward to a few things. We will provide to you is better service in enrollment and financial support. I want to announce to you that we

will open the search for Vice-Chancellor for Students. There were two options to me, one is to hire a long term Vice-Chancellor for two years or to immediately go into the search to hire a Vice-Chancellor for short term. I have chosen to enter the search mode for a Vice-Chancellor for Students. As this search is equivalent to the Vice-Chancellor of Academic Affairs, the process will be the same. It will include the entire university community so it is not an issue for Student Affairs alone. We will have a student representation that we will ask from ASUH. Because it is a campus wide search, we request 50% of this to be faculty. We will be formally asking ASUH within the next few weeks to nominate a member for the search. The process from here onwards will be a process of brief description. Position description will have a few things that will not be changed such as the type of experiences and qualifications that will make the Vice-Chancellor for Students very effective. The Vice-Chancellor for Students is more important for the undergraduate students than graduate students because most concerns for undergraduate students are looked at by the Vice-Chancellor of Academic Affairs.
