### President

a. Mental Health Mtg. with Higher Education Choy and Ichiyama Update

President Kamoshida Last week I meet with Higher Education Chair Choy and Representative Ichiyama. We

tried to get the Mental Health bill passed last legislative session, but unfortunately it didn't pass. I met with them to discuss different approaches we could take to get this bill passed. Some of the suggestions we discussed were creating more awareness. I'll be writing letters to different entities such as the Department of Budget and Finance, asking

if they can have this on their budget. I'll update you all on this later.

b. Commencement Proposal Feedback

President Kamoshida Last general senate meeting April Goodwin of the Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs

did a presentation. I wanted to get your feedback on that before I email her. What did

you think?

SAL Callihan I think this is a good idea. As a personal example, I couldn't make to graduation last

semester because the traffic was so congested.

President Kamoshida April expressed to me that many parents couldn't attend their children's graduation

because of the traffic. They also shut the doors to the stadium because it was filled to

capacity.

SAL Chen I think it's okay, but I think it's weird that the question was posed to us. We can't

imagine the experience of other students ourselves.

SAL Enriquez I enjoyed hearing this solution towards commencement because I know that this has been

a topic that's been brushed to the side. I think our constituents appreciate that they are

attempting a solution towards the commencement ceremony.

Senator Ishii I support it as well. I can't imagine my elderly grandmother going to graduation in the

midst of the huge crowd.

Advisor Manini I think administration has not thought about the fact that a number of years back they got

rid of summer commencement. With the removal of summer commencement, there are students participating in the spring ceremony who haven't graduated yet. We know of students from CSOs who have participated in the commencement ceremony but didn't graduate because they didn't pass classes or turn in paperwork. Or there are people who graduate in the summer but are from outer islands or out of state. Would they want to come back in the fall to participate in the commencement ceremony? We also know that enrollment is going down but graduation rates are going up. I know the absence of the

summer commencement ceremony has caused the number of undergraduates

participating in fall and spring commencement to go up. Graduation is big here and there might be some families who would want to go to their children's friends' ceremony, which may be at a separate time and separate ceremony, so would they really want to come out for another ceremony.

SAL Chen Would it be best to ask for student opinion after the pilot or before?

Advisor Manini Senator Lao I think either is okay.

I think everyone has made very good points. However, in addition to that, I'd like to see a cost-benefits analysis from Administration, because I could see this being potentially

justifiable if it saves a lot of money.

Senator Wang Personally, I don't really care about the ceremony itself. I think what's more important is

the lei-giving ceremony. Being able to split that into two sections allows students who graduated in one ceremony can stay while students who'll graduate in another one will be

free to move around.

Senator Callihan Can I make a suggestion to request numbers of participants in past summer

commencement ceremonies?

President Kamoshida Yes, I'll email her. I'll relay your feedback to April Goodwin.
