Updates from UH Student Caucus

I just wanted to let everyone know that at the most recent meeting this past weekend, the Student Caucus voted to create three standing committees on three issues. So these are the three;

On Post Pandemic Reorganization, so kind of like gathering information on each of the different campuses on post pandemic reorganization and providing input on that.

The second committee is on Student Voices and Transparency, which is the committee that I am a member of. It is kind of trying to ensure that student consultation occurs across all UH campuses, so kind of having conversations about that.

The third one is Civic Duty and Social Justice which Vice President Kim is a member of. That is kind of talking about anti-racism issues, and amplifying civil engagement opportunities for the UH system and things like that.

Those are the three committees that were created for the UH System Caucus.

Post-Pandemic Reorganization Update

If you click on this website that I have linked in the agenda, it takes you to a link that was included in the announcement that Provost Bruno made regarding the deans meeting that took place this past Monday. Basically all of the colleges and schools, provided updates on their own recommendations and response to the initial recommendations made for each of their schools on the Post Pandemic Hawai'i website. Especially if you're a senator for a college or school, I highly recommend that you look at your respective college and if you have any questions, feel free to reach out to us at the reorganization committee. This ties in with the regular consultative meetings that started today. Basically Provost Bruno has requested biweekly meetings with the consultative groups like ASUH, GSO, UHPA which is the faculty union, the faculty senate and all those other councils. Every other Wednesday, from Today, I had the opportunity to attend today's meeting and I will be kind of drafting up my notes and I will share that with everyone.

Something I did want to share with everyone is that in the next, if not the end of this week, the next week, the Mānoa budget team will be updating the Post Pandemic Hawai'i website with significant changes that they've made based on the updates from academic deans and things like that. I can say from Provost Bruno, programs like Dance and Theater, they removed the stop-out for those

programs and others. I have requested that when updates to the website occur that we get notified. I will be sure to send an email out to everyone for outreach and updates.

I had a quick question on what the purpose of the survey is or what the objective is? Is there a specific group of people that we're giving the results of the data to or is it just to have the information available?

What is the purpose of the survey, is it just to gather student feedback, or are we gathering the information to present to a certain group of people like admin or something? Is there a specific objective yet?

Chairperson Kim

There is not a specific objective yet because we don't, personally I don't think it would be wise to come up with a plan to present to faculty or admin on the server, but if there survey does show that there is a need to address it then we will devise a plan to present it to the faculty senate and talk with them about what practices we can establish to help students out. Maybe also Provost Bruno, but no objectives right now.

We're just a little worried if the results did not come back with anything significant there would be nothing to present.

Advisor Manini

When I had seen an email that Junga sent out related to this, it sort of just tucked it in the back of my mind. I was on a faculty listserv, and one of the faculty members, the listserv has a lot of faculty that have been with the university for years, you know researchers, also I've noticed there are faculty members from different UH campuses as well because they respond to questions that are posed. One of the things that were posed recently was about the realistic size of synchronous online courses and they are asking about it in terms of engaging students. What did peers feel about it and what were the opinions about peers of the size issue. Having said that I think it would be interesting to see what students think about it as well because while faculty can deliberate in our online forums about these topics, hearing student voices would be very

beneficial as well. I sent it to Hannah, but I also sent it to Jungha as well and so that the question is copied. I did ask the person who posted it for permission to share it with ASUH. I know the person, and I've worked with him before so I asked him if it would be okay if I share this with ASUH because students might want to chime in on such a thing. I think that I did just send it to Jungha by email, so as the committee deliberates possible questions for a survey etcetera, the person was like yeah we 'd love to hear what students think about this as well. I think having data available from students that care enough to take the survey would be more beneficial than if it's not done at all. I also think it would be beneficial to respond to students feeling frustrated or pressured and have reached out. Those are just my thoughts.

I just checked my email, and unfortunately the content is not in the email. It's just the text not the survey.

There wasn't a survey that they did, they were just asking questions in an email thread. What I did was I cut and pasted the question that they were talking about in the thread. I didn't send the entire email thread, but I can do that too if you want to look at it. Just don't respond to it. It will have comments from different faculty on different campuses, and I haven't asked them permission to share all of that. I only asked the initial poster. I'll go ahead and forward that email thread to you.
