BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Ohana Resource Fair is to assist our diverse UHM student population. By emphasizing our campus and community resources, we aim to help students, such as our student parents and adult learners, succeed in both their academic and professional goals. The Women's Center & SPAM program act as a vital resource hub providing information about social support, community, and campus program services. The SPAM program advocates for pregnant and parenting students while supporting the expansion of student-friendly lactation spaces and family-friendly policies on campus. The UH Women's Center's mission is to help strengthen the multicultural and gender-sensitive aspects of the university and foster an environment free of racism, sexism, and homophobia. Organizations joining us to represent the diversity of our campus community include PAU Violence, LGBTQI Center, The Native Hawaiian Student Services, Health Promotion, and the Office of Veteran Support Services (OVSS).
