SENATE ACT 12-26

TO ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR AN EDUCATIONAL FORUM ON BLACK HISTORY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

To allocate funding to support an educational forum discussing black history and its relationship to education, particularly in Hawai‘i on Friday, February 27th. The forum aims to spread awareness to multiple fields of education with the perspectives of black educators within those spaces.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$4,150.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support) section C2.

Honorarium for moderator\$600.00

Food.....\$2,250.00

Advertising\$500.00

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

The ASUH Finance Committee shall gather necessary paperwork.

ASUH will be the primary sponsor of this event. All funding is pending approval of the ASUH budget by the OVPSS.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 6, 2026 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
