SENATE ACT 39-16

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR AS(YOU)H WEEK

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funding for AS(YOU)H Week, a three-day event dedicated to increasing awareness of the ASUH and its vision to “empower students through advocacy.” Held in Bale Courtyard on Monday, April 18, to Wednesday, April 20, AS(YOU)H Week will foster interaction between Senate members and undergraduates, enabling Senate members to inform students about resources and to directly hear the comments and concerns of those they serve.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$3,450.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).
